- 7. The scholarship is for funds up to \$1,000 per semester for four years total for tuition and books at an accredited college or university of the awardee's choice. All funds are paid directly to the applicable school.
- 8. During the course of the four-year period applicable to the scholarship, grades and other pertinent information must be submitted periodically to the trustees before the funds for the following semester will be paid. Grades must be maintained at a higher level in each course taken.
