- ► Extracurricular Achievement-Commitment & accomplishment
- ▶ Interesting, well-written essays. Edit for grammatical errors. ▶ Detailed, enthusiastic recommendations from teachers, coaches, counselors,
- and bosses. Colleges want to know how you think, how you spend time (by choice or necessity) and what you bring to a classroom or extracurricular group.
